(TESOL 履修証明プログラム)

Students in the non-degree **Certificate Program in TESOL** take the same courses as Master's students and all admission requirements for the Master's apply to the Certificate. However, unlike the Master's, which takes a minimum of two years to complete, the Certificate is completed in one year.

All Certificate Program requirements are completed in one year (two semesters).

*Those who are unable to complete the Certificate Program in one year may complete the remaining credits for 65,000 yen per credit.

Transfer to the Master's in TESOL

Successful completion of the Certificate Program may enable students to transition to the Master's in TESOL and further advance their professional expertise. All 10-13 credits earned in the Certificate Program are transferable to the Master's in TESOL.

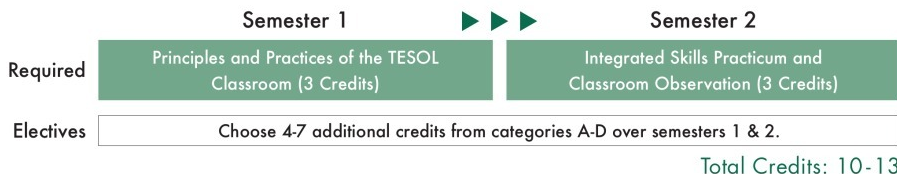

The Certificate in TESOL is a one-year non-degree program designed to cultivate essential knowledge and abilities of English language teachers. The program emphasizes reflective teaching practices and guides educators in making principled decisions in their classrooms.

Certificate Program in TESOL Courses

Ten credits are required to complete the program. An additional three credits may be taken at no cost for a total of 13 credits. The following two required courses and additional credits are taken in consecutive semesters.
